The 4 year cohort graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of students in the Class of 2015 cohort who received a standard, advanced, or adult diploma by the total number of students in the cohort. The students in the cohort are determined by the students who started in 9<sup>th</sup> grade 2011-2012 plus those who transferred in minus those who transferred out to another degree granting school.
