

GRADUATION RATE-PERFORMANCE ZONES

Goal 3: Increase the percentage of students graduating each year.

Please note: The 4-year cohort graduation rate is calculated by dividing the number of students in the Class of 2017 cohort who received a standard, advanced, or adult diploma by the total number of students in the cohort. The students in the cohort are determined by the students who started in 9th grade in 2013-2014 plus those students who transferred in minus those who transferred out to another degree granting school.
